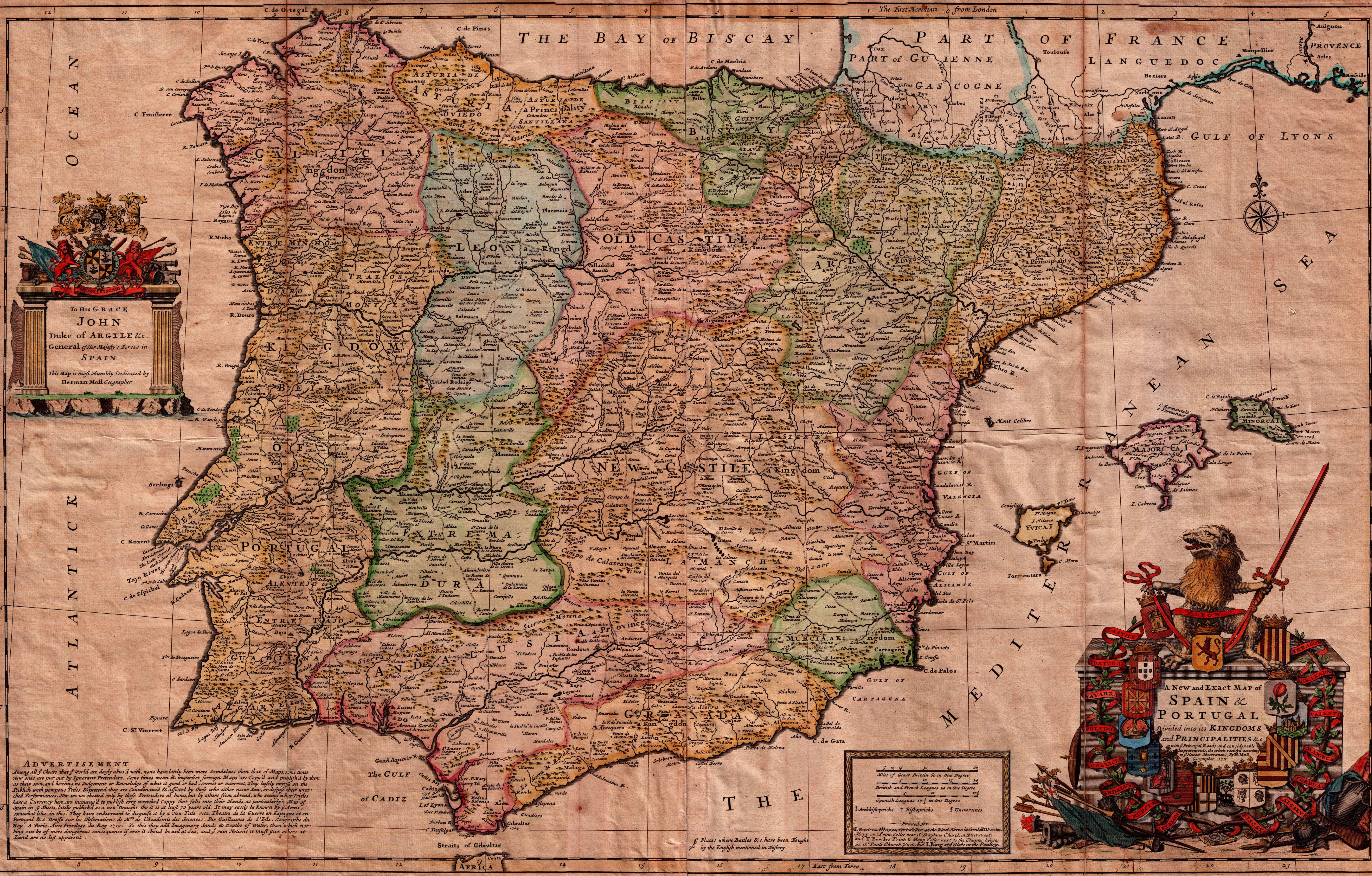




ADVERTISEMENT
